PRECAUTIONS

- Interfyl should not be used in clinically infected sites.
- Do not use Interfyl for intravenous, intra-arterial, intra-ocular or intrathecal applications.
- The contents are sterile if the vial/syringe (container) is unopened and undamaged.
- Do not resterilize.
- Interfyl must be used prior to the expiration date on the product pouch.
- Once opened, Interfyl must be used within two hours or discarded per institutional procedures.

If a recipient had an adverse reaction related to previous use of Interfyl, do not re-apply.






Because of its unique properties, Interfyl Human Connective Tissue is a treatment allowing your body to repair damaged tissue naturally.

The tissue goes through extensive screening and is processed according to the Food & Drug Administration (FDA) and American Association of Blood Banks' (AABB) requirements. The processed tissue is absorbed into your body as a replacement of damaged tissue.

When standard treatment therapies such as stretching exercises and ice, pain medication or cortisone shots have failed, Interfyl can help replace and supplement damaged tissue caused by soft tissue injuries.



Interfyl provides a structural foundation for weak, damaged tissue. The cell-friendly scaffold provides a favorable environment for cell attachment.



Cells migrate and attach to the Interfyl scaffold. Your attached cells then support the repair of the damaged tissue.

You can get this treatment right in the office. No surgery needed.

How is the Procedure Performed?

- Your doctor will numb the affected area and then insert a small needle, placing Interfyl Flowable in the area surrounding your damaged or injured tissue.
- When the numbness wears off, you may feel some pain for 24 - 48 hours as Interfyl Flowable diffuses. Your doctor may recommend some ways to help manage any discomfort.
- Following the procedure, avoid high-impact activities for several weeks, as directed by your doctor.
